Replacement of Morgan Hill Water Tanks

Easton Suburban Water Authority is undertaking a project to replace the two concrete one million gallon water tanks that reside on Morgan Hill Road, just south of the intersection with Cedarville Road. These two tanks will be replaced with two new steel water tanks. In order to maintain adequate water service to customers in the area, the project will be performed in two phases. The first phase will consist of one tank being taken out of service, demolished, and a new tank will be constructed in its place. Once this new tank is in operation, the second tank will be taken out of service, demolished and a new tank will be constructed in its place.

This project is expected to begin on February 25, 2008, with the demolition of the first tank. The first tank should be erected, painted, tested, and placed in service during September 2008. Once this is done, the demolition of the second tank will begin. It is anticipated that erection of the second tank will be completed in early 2009. The painting and testing of the second tank will be performed in the spring of 2009.

The contractors will be working primarily between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday; however, there may be situations when work will be performed on the weekends due to weather conditions.

There will be no work performed in the Morgan Hill Road Right of Way during the project; however, there will be some minor construction traffic on Morgan Hill Road. Construction warning signs will be placed on Morgan Hill Road both north and south of the site warning of the project area. On occasion, there may be a brief need for flag people on Morgan Hill Road as large deliveries are made to the project. During these situations, proper Pennsylvania Department of Transportation requirements for traffic control and flag people will be followed.
