Dear Mr. Chrin:

The Department has approved your request for a minor permit modification for the use of a MSE berm at the perimeter of Stage 8 and to develop a southern borrow area within the existing permit boundary. This modification application, dated December 22, 2010, was received by the Department on December 23, 2010, and was prepared by Civil & Engineering Consultants, Inc., 4000 Triangle Lane, Export, PA 15632. Supplemental information was received on August 18, 2011.

Enclosed as part of this approval is a Form 13-A. Any conditions stated on the enclosed Form 13-A modify and replace permit conditions regarding your permit. All other items and conditions of your permit shall remain in force and effect.


Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal, pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. Section 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa. C.S., Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, 400 Market Street, P.O. Box 8457, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8457, 717-787-3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, 800-654-5984. Appeals must be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. Copies of the appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure may be obtained from the Board. The appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure are also available in Braille or on audiotape from the Secretary to the Board at 717-787-3483. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS ACTION, YOUR APPEAL MUST REACH THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS. YOU DO NOT NEED A LAWYER TO FILE AN APPEAL WITH THE BOARD.

IMPORTANT LEGAL RIGHTS ARE AT STAKE, HOWEVER, SO YOU SHOULD SHOW THIS DOCUMENT TO A LAWYER AT ONCE. IF YOU CANNOT AFFORD A LAWYER, YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR FREE PRO BONO REPRESENTATION. CALL THE SECRETARY TO THE BOARD (717-787-3483) FOR MORE INFORMATION.

MODIFICATION TO SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND/OR PROCESSING PERMIT

Under the provisions of Act 97, the Solid Waste Management Act of July 7, 1980, Solid Waste Permit

Number 100022 issued on (date original permit was issued) May 27, 1993 to
(permittee) Chrin Brothers Sanitary Landfill
(address) 635 Industrial Drive
Easton, PA 18042

is hereby modified as follows:

The traditional earthen berm proposed for the northern boundary of Stage 8 may be replaced with a MSE berm subject to the following conditions:

1. Provide the name, affiliation and qualifications of the CQA professional engineer who will be overseeing construction of the berm. This engineer is to be on site full time during construction. The CQA engineer must be from an outside firm (not affiliated with Chrin).
2. Provide information as to when the product manufacturer, Strata Systems, will have a representative on site and their role.
3. Provide written notification to the DEP at least one week prior to construction start indicating that construction is to begin and requisite construction schedule.
4. Provide the schedule for all pre-construction and construction meetings to be held on site. Inform DEP in a timely manner of any changes in construction and meeting schedules.

The southern borrow area to be used for this construction is hereby approved.

This modification shall be attached to the existing Solid Waste Permit described above and shall become a part thereof effective on

September 23, 2011
