#### Comments:

The PA Department of Environmental Protection (Department) conducted a routine complete inspection on December 20, 2021 at 1034 hours at Chrin Bros. Sanitary Landfill (Chrin). Representing the Department was Amy Faulch (this inspector). Joseph Klobusicky provided a site tour and was interviewed on behalf of Chrin. See the 12/20/21 odor patrol log for weather details.

The following Department personnel have entered the landfill since the 10/6/21 inspection: A. Faulch and R. Wysocki on 10/6/21; M. Glogowski on 11/18/21; C. Madden and M. Vipond on 12/1/21; R. Malizia, A. Faulch and M. Vipond on 12/13/21; and A. Faulch on 12/20/21.

#### SITE TOUR:

Prior to entering the landfill, this inspector conducted an odor patrol in the areas surrounding the landfill. No landfill-related odors were detected during this odor patrol. See attached 12/20/21 odor patrol log for details.

This inspector entered the landfill at 1127 hours. Chrin was operating a dual working face. One truck was dumping select waste in Cell 9A. Two trucks were dumping construction/demolition waste in cell Cell 7. A moderate garbage odor was detected in the immediate area of the working face in Cell 9A. A moderate gas odor was detected in the immediate area of the working face in Cell 7 because some wells were unhooked while filling in this area. Intermediate cover in this working face area appeared adequate.

Additional intermediate cover has been being applied and seeded in the Stage 3D area. Chrin has been working to bring the lower sloped in 3D to grade and gas line work is being conducted in this area in preparation for installation of final cap. No significant mud or dust was observed along the site access roads. Chrin has continued blasting in the expansion area.

Flow meters for Flares 1,3 and 4 were calibrated on 10/25/21. Flare 3 and 4 were in operation at the time of this inspection:

#### **COMPLAINT INVESTIGATIONS:**

The Department received seven odor complaints since the last inspection on 10/6/21. See attached odor complaint log. Complaints were followed up with odor patrols conducted by Chrin on 11/8/21, and by the Department on 11/8/21, 12/9/21 and 1/12/22.

Line item #13: Chrin had 88 overweight trucks in October, 100 overweight vehicles in November and 80 Overweight vehicles in December 2021.

Line item #20-23: Daily inspection logs were reviewed by at the time of this inspection. Chrin's odor patrols and odor control measures appear to be following their nuisance minimization and control plan.

Line item #24: Daily tonnage records were reviewed. There did not appear to be any exceedances of the 2,000-ton daily limit. The greatest one-day tonnages are as follows:

10/28/21: 857 tons 11/4/21: 100 tons 12/30/21: 755 tons

Line item #25-31: Chrin's stationary radiation meters was last calibrated on 7/8/21. Chrin's handheld radiation meter was last calibrated on 8/5/21. Radiation source checks were reviewed on site. Chrin has had no radiation hits since the last inspection.


