



Williams Township is helping with free-roaming and feral cats!

Do you have a stray cat or cats in your neighborhood? Do they keep having babies?

Williams Township is pleased to announce they have entered into a contract with **No Nonsense Neutering** for free-roaming or feral cats within the Township!

The process is simple:

- A. **Make an appointment** with No Nonsense Neutering.
- B. Come to the Township Office and **pick up a voucher**. The **voucher costs \$40.00**, payable when you obtain the voucher.
- C. No Nonsense Neutering has traps available for use.
- D. **The cat is taken to its appointment** where the following happens:
 1. **Spay/neuter**
 2. **Ear tipped (universal sign that the cat was trapped, neutered and returned[TNR])**
 3. **Ear Mites**
 4. **Rabies vaccine**
 5. **Flea/tick**
 6. **All medications for surgery (including pain medicine)**

You keep the cat for 24 hours after surgery where it was trapped (in a garage, shed or other shelter).

The cat is then released where it was trapped. There are some instances where the cat may be able to go to a "barn home" if necessary.

The cat lives a healthier life and stops reproducing! A win-win for you and your neighborhood.
