

SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM 2024

The Williams Township Recreation Board Summer Recreation Program will run from Monday, June 17 through July 26, 2023. The program will be open from 8:30 AM to 3:30 PM, Monday through Friday, weather permitting. **The program could be closed in the event of rain.** Also, on July 4, 2023 the Program will be closed for the Holiday.

The program is open to Williams Township and Glendon residents between the ages of 5 and 13. All 5-year-olds must have a birth certificate present at registration for verification of age.

All children attending the program must submit a completed emergency card.

If your child plans to stay for the entire day, we suggest that a labeled lunch and drink be packed.

The Director of the program is Darlene. All counselors will have shirts to identify a person in charge. If you have any concerns about the program, please take them to Darlene, immediately.

THE FOLLOWING RULES WILL BE ENFORCED:

(1) NO FIGHTING/NO BULLYING

First offense---one week off the playground

Second offense---off the entire summer

(2) NO VULGAR LANGUAGE

First offense---three days off the playground

Second offense---one week off the playground

Third offense---off the entire summer

(3) NO DISRESPECT TO THE DIRECTOR OR OTHER STAFF

This includes hitting, spitting and throwing anything.

First offense---OFF THE ENTIRE SUMMER

(4) PARENTS/GUARDIANS MUST BE ON TIME PICKING UP CHILDREN

First offense---verbal notice from staff

Second offense---off the entire summer

(5) CELL PHONE USE STRONGLY DISCOURAGED

This includes prank calls and invading people's privacy with videos or photos.

First offense – Verbal warning from staff and discussion with a parent/guardian.

Second offense – three days off of the playground

Third offense – off for the rest of the summer.

(6) STAY OUT OF THE WOODS!

If the Children lose something they should tell one of the counselors.

(7) CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE PARKING LOT OR NEAR THE ROAD

(8) CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED TO GO HOME WITH ANYONE WHO IS NOT LISTED ON YOUR EMERGENCY CARE CARD, AND WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW ID.

(9) EVERYONE MUST SIGN THEIR CHILD IN AND THEY MUST SIGN WHEN PICKING THE CHILD UP. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. IT IS FOR YOUR CHILD'S PROTECTION INSIDE THE COMMUNITY CENTER. PLEASE BRING PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION.

REMEMBER, NEVER GO WITH SOMEONE WITHOUT YOUR GUARDIAN'S PERMISSION, THAT INCLUDES FRIENDS AND STRANGERS!

Please go over these rules with your children and fill out the registration form making sure that you sign in the appropriate places. Thank you for your cooperation and for the cooperation of your children. Have a great summer and enjoy the Summer Recreation Program.
